BAR Rolls Out Latest Consumer Education and Outreach Effort

Two important responsibilities of the Bureau of Automotive Repair (BAR) are to educate consumers about their rights and responsibilities in the automotive repair marketplace and to promote compliance with the mandates of the Smog Check Program.

With this in mind, BAR rolled out its DriveHealthy consumer education campaign last year. The DriveHealthy effort was designed to help remind Californians about the importance of keeping vehicles properly maintained, which helps to reduce harmful emissions.

The importance of this message cannot be overstated, as California has more cars than any other state as well as the dirtiest air. Poor air quality can lead to a range of health problems, including asthma, heart disease, bronchitis, and respiratory infections.

The central message of the DriveHealthy campaign resonated with the public. People appreciated learning about how they can contribute to improving air quality through common sense vehicle maintenance practices, such as monitoring tire pressure and changing air filters and oil according to their owner's manual. They also developed a better understanding about the relationship between poor air quality and its adverse effect on the most vulnerable populations, particularly the very young and the very old.

Based on the public's reaction to this effort, BAR began rolling out its latest consumer education effort this past spring. This year's campaign really builds on last year's efforts and talks about the issues important to all Californians, which

is to help clean the air we breathe and to save money during these economic times.

This year's effort places greater emphasis on the Consumer Assistance Program. This is significant since many consumers need financial assistance toward the repair of a vehicle after it fails a biennial Smog Check inspection. Many consumers are now more inclined to retire their vehicle for \$1,000 and use the money toward the purchase of a newer, lower emitting vehicle.

Another message in this year's effort is BAR's free auto body inspection program. Under this program, consumers who own a vehicle that has undergone collision repairs can contact BAR, which will then send a representative to inspect the vehicle. The inspection is designed to ensure that the auto body work that the consumer or their insurer paid for was actually completed and performed correctly. The consumer education effort is designed to introduce consumers to this free inspection service and to encourage them to contact BAR toll free at 866.799.3811 to schedule an appointment.

The campaign is a statewide effort, with particular emphasis on the San Joaquin Valley and the greater Los Angeles area. To reach its target audience, the campaign incorporates community events, partnerships and promotions. It also uses a variety of cost-effective media, including radio; newspapers; gas pump toppers; billboards; and Web sites, including a Spanish-language Web site.

I'm particularly proud of our Spanish-language Web site, as it provides important information to a large segment of California's population about the resources available at BAR and the health consequences of poor air quality. The information is consistent with the content of our English-language Web site.

LPFET Test and Repair Tips

Since implementing the Low Pressure Fuel Evaporative Test (LPFET), the Bureau of Automotive Repair (BAR) has identified several technical issues concerning the testing of certain vehicles, adaptor gaskets, and the Pinch Point Database.

Testing Ford Ranger and Mazda Pickups

BAR has determined that 1988 through 1995 Ford Ranger and 1994 Mazda B-Series pickups (both use the same chassis) fail more often than other vehicles. BAR reviewed the cause of this failure and determined a crack frequently develops in these vehicles just above the fuel tank inlet in the rubber filler neck hose. To address this problem, aftermarket filler necks are now available. Some of the aftermarket replacement filler necks come complete with the rubber hoses and metal threaded flapper door assembly. BAR has discovered, however, that some manufacturers do not always properly weld the flapper door assembly. This results in an evaporative system leak causing the vehicle to fail the LPFET. In addition, BAR has found that cap threads on some aftermarket filler neck assemblies are too shallow in comparison to the original equipment manufacturer's (OEM) fuel cap threads. As a result, these aftermarket parts do not fit properly.

Aftermarket components must match the functionality of the OEM component or be approved by the California Air Resources Board (ARB), which approves them for use as replacement parts in the form of an Executive Order (EO) number. If you are testing a California vehicle that is fitted with an aftermarket filler neck assembly and you find the filler neck adapter's thread size does not fit and does not match the OEM, check to see if the assembly was assigned an EO by ARB. If it does, enter "N/A" for the test result on the BAR-97 analyzer and contact ARB at 626.242.4450 to report the problem. If there is no EO approval number, fail the vehicle on the visual inspection for having a non-compliant modified device.

Repair Tip

If a Ford Ranger or Mazda pickup truck fails the LPFET and needs the filler neck assembly replaced, you may use the metal threaded flapper door assembly from the old filler neck (if it is in good working condition) and attach it to the new rubber hoses from the new aftermarket part and connect them to the fuel tank. This will help alleviate aftermarket filler neck problems.

LPFET Filler Neck Adaptor Gaskets

While performing an LPFET, if you find that the filler neck adaptor gasket is too thin (not sealing properly), it is an acceptable practice to move gaskets from one filler neck adaptor to another to achieve a proper seal.

Gasket kits can be purchased from LPFET manufacturers. If you wish to order gasket kits, the part numbers are as follows:

- > The part number for SysTech is 4700-045.
- > The part number for ESP/Waekon is 31231-4-10 or 11400-318.

LPFET Pliers

BAR certifies the pliers used to perform a LPFET. These are the only pliers that may be used in the test. Pliers must meet all of the following criteria:

- > They should apply sufficient pressure to completely block any flow at all points in the jaw area while also leaving the hose undamaged and serviceable.
- > They must be lockable to allow the technician the flexibility to work from the LPFET unit while maintaining a good seal on the fuel vapor hose.
- > They must be capable of performing 5,000 clamping cycles and still maintain their performance.
- > They must be long enough to allow the technician to reach the necessary hoses.

During plier certification testing, BAR found many pliers failed. Some did not seal properly. Some broke during the 5,000 cycle test. Others cut vapor hoses because the edges were too sharp, and some did not clamp properly. Finally, some had lock rings that were too small forcing the technician to crimp hoses so tight that they were being damaged. Technicians are responsible to look for signs of wear or damage as this will impact the pliers' ability to produce a tight crimp as well as lock successfully.

Some vehicles have easily accessible tank vapor lines while others are not easily accessible. In tight areas, BAR has found that longer pliers with rounded jaw edges reduce hose damage and have a good success rate sealing the lines. If you are looking to purchase pliers, be sure the sharp edges in the jaws have been smoothed and the pliers have locking capability. If they do not have these properties, they are not BAR certified.

LPFET Pinch Point Database

The Pinch Point Database is a software program that assists technicians in finding the fuel vapor hose and illustrates the suggested crimping locations. The Pinch Point Database is not to be used to determine the testability of a vehicle. There may be some instances where the database indicates that the vehicle is not testable or a picture may not be accurate due to the number of vehicle models. Some vehicles may appear to be untestable because the flapper door seals so tightly that the LPFET unit will generate an error such as "can't fill." Ultimately, technicians must decide which vehicles can or cannot be tested.

Joining the Green Station Recognition Program

What is the Green Station Recognition Program?

The Green Station Recognition Program, which is administered by the California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) in cooperation with the Bureau of Automotive Repair (BAR), is designed to recognize automotive repair shops and Smog Check stations that engage in environmentally-friendly practices as part of their normal business. These practices range from recycling used oil and coolants to using aqueous-based parts cleaners instead of solvents.

When can I apply?

As long as you have a valid Automotive Repair Dealer (ARD) registration, you can apply anytime.

How do I apply to be certified as a Green Station?

Visit the Bureau of Automotive Repair's Web site at www.smogcheck.ca.gov and download and complete the following documents:

- > Green Station application
- > Pollution Prevention Checklist
- > Environmental Benefits form

In addition, you must provide a copy of your most recent hazardous materials inspection and air district inspection reports.

Where do I send a completed application package?

What is the application processing time?

The application processing time is four to six weeks from the time DTSC receives your application to the time you receive your recognition certificate.

What are the fees associated with becoming a Green Station?

There are no fees to join the Green Station Recognition Program.

What are the criteria to become a Green Station?

DTSC will review and evaluate the information provided on your Environmental Benefits and Pollution Prevention Checklist forms and determine if you are qualified.

Once I submit the required information, how do I know if I am approved?

You will receive your recognition certificate from DTSC. Your status as a green station will also be posted on BAR's Web site and the *Automotive Repair and Smog Check News*.



What are the advantages of becoming a Green Station?

There are several advantages to joining the program, some of them include:

- > Potential cost-savings for your shop, as reducing waste generation can cut disposal cost.
- > Reduction of exposure to hazardous chemical for your employees.
- > A valuable marketing tool to use for your environmentally-conscious customers.
- > Recognition of your participation via a DTSC-issued certification, acknowledgment in BAR's quarterly newsletter, and identification on BAR's Web site.

How long is the Green Station recognition certificate valid?

The Green Station recognition certificate is valid for three years. Each year, you will be required to perform a self-audit. Self certification involves completing the Pollution Prevention Checklist and the Environmental Benefits forms each calendar year and submitting them to DTSC. At the end of the three year certification, you must reapply with DTSC and you will be scheduled for a re-inspection.

If I sell my business or move, can I take my Green Station recognition certification with me?

No, you must reapply.

WE GET QUESTIONS...

on Auto Body Repairs

Are "tear down" estimates allowed for auto body repair?

Yes. Not only are they allowed but they are encouraged in order for you to prepare the best possible repair estimate. A tear down gives you, the repair facility, the opportunity to see all the damage to the vehicle so you can write a complete estimate and eliminate potential supplements. It also gives the customer an opportunity to make an informed decision about whether to repair the vehicle. Remember, a tear down estimate must include the cost and the maximum time to reassemble the vehicle if the customer decides not to repair it. The estimate must also include the cost of gaskets, seals and other items that may be destroyed during disassembly.

What if I will not be able to reassemble the vehicle after the tear down?

It is not uncommon to cut away some components to fully assess the damage to a vehicle. If a tear down will prevent you from returning the vehicle to the condition it was in when it was brought to you, document that fact on your estimate and notify the customer before starting any work on the vehicle. By notifying the customer of this fact prior to giving the estimate, you will not be required to reassemble the vehicle.

Must I give a written estimate when I perform warranty repairs or just perform a minor adjustment to the vehicle?

Yes. You must obtain customer authorization and provide an invoice showing the work to be completed, even if it is performed under warranty or at no charge.

I want to perform collision repairs. Are there equipment requirements for auto body repair shops?

Yes. Shops must have equipment for painting and for structural repairs. These requirements are as follows:

Painting

If you are going to perform automotive painting, you are required to have all of the equipment capable of applying exterior corrosion resistant primers, anticorrosion compounds, and topcoats. You are also required to have current reference manuals necessary to paint and repair nonstructural damage.

Structural Repairs

If you are going to perform structural repairs, you are required to have:

- > Current reference manuals necessary to diagnose, section, replace, or repair structural damage.
- > A three dimensional measuring system that can locate points with the dimensions of length, width and height, relative to three defined reference planes.
- > A four point anchoring system capable of holding a vehicle in a stationary position during structural and body pulls.
- > Equipment capable of multiple body and structural pulls. You will need a MIG (Metal Inert Gas) welder with an output of at least 110 amps for unibody repairs and an output of 200 amps for conventional frame repairs or capable of meeting trade standards for the work being performed.
- > Corrosion protection equipment for treating enclosed areas on unibodies and frame assemblies including pressurized spray equipment, flexible and rigid wands capable of reaching full length inside enclosed areas, spray heads capable of 360 degree spray application, and spray heads capable of a fan shaped pattern.

Refer to California Code of Regulations section 3351.5 for the requirements for performing structural repairs.

Education First Program Expands


Program now offered to existing automotive repair dealers

In March 2008, the Bureau of Automotive Repair (BAR) launched the Education First Program as part of its ongoing commitment to provide education and information to Automotive Repair Dealers (ARDs). In its first year, BAR made more than 3,000 presentations. The response to this proactive effort has been positive.

The program consists of a visit to the shop by a BAR field representative. The visit is less than two hours in length. While at the shop, a BAR representative will meet with owners and/or managers to discuss automotive repair-related laws and proper estimate and invoice procedures. The representative will also discuss certain aspects of BAR's operations and the services it provides licensees and consumers. Participants also have an opportunity to ask questions and share their concerns and observations. The representative will leave a business card, giving the ARD a way to contact the local field office should any issues arise.

"BAR's mission is to enforce those laws that protect consumers in the automotive repair marketplace," notes Kristin Triepke, Deputy Chief of BAR's Enforcement and Field Operations Division. "Education First goes a long way to helping registrants understand those laws, as well as BAR's policies and procedures," she notes.

Although the program was initially created to help new licensees, due to its popularity, Education First is now available to all licensed ARDs, regardless of how long they have been in business.



Personal, one-on-one meetings between BAR representatives and shop owners and staff are an important part of the Education First Program.

Adds Sherry Mehl, BAR Chief, "BAR is here to help, and the Education First Program serves as an important tool for educating shops because the presentations emphasize ways of promoting better business practices, improving customer relations, and a better understanding of the law."

Catalytic Converter Inspection Alert

Due to a production error, catalytic converters produced by Walker Manufacturing Company before January 26, 2009 have some labels with an extra zero on the California Air Resource Board (ARB) Executive Order (EO) number. Regular labels have the EO marked as D-182-XX, while the irregular ones have the EO marked as D-182-0XX. The affected catalytic converters have EO numbers D-182-37 through D-182-44.

This labeling error does not affect the performance of the catalytic converters, nor should it render the catalytic converters non-compliant or illegal during a Smog Check inspection. When verifying these EO numbers on ARB's database, please do not input the extra "0". Instead, type in the regular EO number to access a copy of the specific Executive Order in the database. Traffic Pollution Linked to New Cases of Asthma

New findings support California's efforts to reduce smog

A recent study by the journal *Environmental Health Perspectives* found childhood asthma rates could increase by as much as 30 percent because of the exposure to higher levels of traffic-related air pollution.

The eight-year study followed 217 non-asthmatic children from a wide area of Southern California. Home air monitors allowed scientists to compare children's exposure to air pollution and newly-diagnosed cases of asthma. The study found that higher amounts of nitrogen dioxide, a constituent of smog, are associated with the development of childhood asthma.

"California's prosperity depends on the choices we make to protect our children," said California Air Resource Board (ARB) Chairman Mary D. Nichols. "This study underlines the need for clean air, giving us the benefits of a fully healthy population."

The study is the latest to come from the Southern California Children's Health Study, a project pioneered by the ARB in the early 1990s. This study, the most extensive investigation into air pollution's impact on the young, has provided data that resulted in over 100 peer-reviewed articles with several groundbreaking results.

One of these studies found that children exercising on days with high ozone concentrations also had an increased likelihood of developing asthma.

"Good air quality is fundamental to good health," added Nichols.

Recent studies have shown that the reduction of air pollution is also economically beneficial. It diminishes the costs associated with lost work and school days, medications to address illnesses, hospital visits, and premature deaths.

Diesel-Powered Vehicle Testing Update

Testing scheduled to begin January 2010

Assembly Bill 1488 (Chapter 739, Statutes of 2007) requires the Bureau of Automotive Repair (BAR) to incorporate diesel-powered vehicles into the Smog Check Program beginning January 2010. The law affects 1998 and newer model year vehicles with a gross vehicle weight rating of up to 13,999 pounds.

BAR developed proposed regulations to add diesel-powered vehicle testing to regulation. The diesel Smog Check inspection includes a test of the on-board diagnostic (OBD) system, a visual check of the emission control systems, and a diesel visible smoke test.

BAR held a regulatory hearing for the proposed regulations in Sacramento on August 31, 2009. The public had an opportunity to make comments about the proposed regulations. More information will be sent to Smog Check stations via Electronic Transmission blasts and to anyone on BAR's Interested Parties mailing list.

BAR's Vehicle Retirement Incentive Scheduled to Increase to \$1,500

Incentive helps low-income consumers

The Bureau of Automotive Repair (BAR) is working to adopt regulations that will offer \$1,500 to low-income consumers who own a vehicle that fails its biennial inspection and opt to retire it through the Consumer Assistance Program (CAP). The increased incentive will be offered in early 2010. All other consumers, including those who own a directed vehicle, will continue to receive \$1,000 when they participate in CAP's vehicle retirement option.

"Increasing the vehicle retirement incentive should help a large number of consumers junk their high polluting cars and purchase newer, lower emitting vehicles," notes

Sherry Mehl, BAR Chief. "This will help us achieve our emissions reduction goals and improve the air we breathe," she adds.

Stations will be notified of the effective date of the increased incentive. In addition, a new, streamlined application reflecting the change will be distributed prior to implementing the increased incentive. A supply of the new application will be mailed to all Gold Shield stations. Get on the BAR Mailing List

The Bureau of Automotive Repair (BAR) maintains several mailing lists of interested parties who have asked to receive information such as notices, bulletins, newsletters, workshop flyers, and other items related to BAR operations.

Under Government Code section 11346.4, BAR is required to establish the Regulatory Actions Notice Interested Parties mailing list. In accordance with Government Code section 14911, BAR is also required to correct, verify, and update this list annually. The list is primarily used to mail regulation hearing notices, regulation workshop invitations, informational meeting invitations, and other miscellaneous information.

The Regulatory Actions Notice list is **not** used for mailing the *Automotive Repair and Smog Check News*. Requests to be added to the newsletter mailing list are often confused with the Regulatory Actions Notice list. To help BAR staff direct mailing list requests to the correct location, we have provided a form for you to fill out. If you are a licensed Smog Check technician or a registered Automotive Repair Dealer (ARD), you are automatically placed on the list that is used to mail the newsletter and other official notices. As a result, you should already be receiving the newsletter.

Here's how to choose the mailing list that provides the information in which you're most interested. First, choose whether you wish to be placed on the newsletter or the regulation mailing list. You may select both, if you want to receive both.

If you elect to be placed on the Regulatory mailing list, you may further refine the information you want to receive by selecting from any of the sub-categories listed below. For example, if you select "General" you will receive information, invitations, and notices from all categories, but if you select "Smog Check" you will only receive information, invitations, and notices related to the Smog Check Program.

If you are already on any of BAR's mailing lists and want to remain on those lists, you do not need to take any action. As required by Government Code 14911, an annual update notification will be mailed to you during January or February of each year to confirm that you wish to remain on the Regulatory Notice mailing list.
